ATHLETIC CONTRACT

This contract has been designed to bring total understanding among student athletes, their parents, and school personnel. We ask that all participants and parents read and sign this contract, indicating full knowledge of the rules, regulations, and commitment. Participation in sports programs at LILA school requires this.

The rules stated in this contract have been established to assure the successful operation of the athletic programs. These rules are set to assure fairness for all involved. The following are the Basic Rules of Behavior for all participants in the LILA school Athletic Program.

RULES OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

The athlete should keep in mind that fair play is applauded and in order to practice good sportsmanship, you must live up to the following rules:

- Play the game for the game's sake.
- Be fair at all times, no matter what it costs.
- Be obedient to the rules.
- Work for the good of the team.
- Accept gracefully the decision of the officials.
- Conduct yourself, at all times, with honor and dignity.

Each student must show respect for the opponent and officials at all times. Good sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of others and suggests the importance of conforming to the spirit of the rules.

RULES OF CONDUCT

The following list of standards and rules of conduct consist of the essentials necessary to maintain team discipline, good citizenship, and favorable public relations. We would like it to be fair so that all concerned will accept enforcement of the rules.

All athletes shall abide by a code of ethics which will earn them the honor and respect that participation and competition in the sport program. Any conduct that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team or the school will not be tolerated.

Citizenship and Sportsmanship

In the eyes of the teacher and the public, citizenship goes with sportsmanship.

Any act of unsportsmanlike conduct in practice or games may lead to immediate disciplinary action, which may include suspension or dismissal from the squad.

Practice/Game Attendance

Regular attendance at all practices and games along with promptness is imperative. Unexcused absences from a game or continued unexcused absences from practice may result in dismissal from the team.

Any student who demonstrates poor team morale can be dismissed by the coach with the approval of the director of Athletics.

Disciplinary procedure

Disciplinary infractions of school rules while attendance at, or while being transferred to or from, an athletic event come under the jurisdiction of the regular school disciplinary procedures.

The coach must inform the principal and the director of athletics of such infractions. The coach may add to the punishment from the school but cannot bypass ordinary procedures.

Since discipline is a vital ingredient to a team's success, athletes can be disciplined for the following infractions:

- Unexcused absence from practice or game;
- Failure to attend team meetings;
- Being tardy to a practice or game;
- Lack of sportsmanship;
- Breaking training rules;

Sanctioned disciplinary procedures include:

- Suspension or expulsion from the team (only instated with permission from the coach and director of athletics)

- Benching (sitting out of practice or game as designated by coach).
